We would like to acknowledge this land that we meet on today is the traditional land of the eg. Kaurna people and that we respect their spiritual relationship with their country. We also acknowledge the Kaurna people as the custodians of this region and that their cultural and heritage beliefs are still important to those living today.

PRESENTATION OF CANDIDATES

Commentator: Add celebrant's name here, I wish to present to you the following young people who have asked to be confirmed. During the past months they have grown and journeyed together, reflecting on their lives and their own experiences. At the same time, they have grown in knowledge and love of God: that same knowledge and love they have shared within their families and within the life of our Church.

I now present the candidates for Confirmation. Children, as I call your name I invite you to stand in your place and remain standing until all the names have been called.

Celebrant briefly addresses the children and then invites them to sit as he preaches the homily.

HOMILY: Celebrant

RENEWAL OF BAPTISMAL PROMISES

Celebrant: My dear young people, before you are confirmed I invite you to come

forward and stand before the congregation as you make your own the promises your parents and godparents made for you at your baptism.

The children come forward and stand before Celebrant.

Celebrant: Do you renounce Satan, and all his works, and all his empty show?

Candidates: I do.

Celebrant: Do you believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth?

Candidates I do.

Celebrant: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,

who was born of the Virgin Mary, suffered death and was buried,

rose again from the dead

and is seated at the right hand of the Father?

Candidates I do.

Celebrant: Do you believe in the Holy Spirit,

the Lord, the giver of life

who today through the Sacrament of Confirmation

is given to you in a special way

just as he was given to the Apostles on the day of Pentecost?

Candidates I do.

Celebrant: Do you believe in the holy Catholic Church,

the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body,

and life everlasting?

Candidates I do.

Celebrant: This is our faith. This is the faith of the Church.

We are proud to profess it in Christ Jesus our Lord.

All: Amen

THE LAYING ON OF HANDS

Then Celebrant, facing the people, with hands joined, says:

Celebrant: Dearly beloved,

Let us pray to God the almighty Father for these, his adopted sons and daughters, already born again to eternal life in Baptism,

that he will graciously pour out the Holy Spirit upon them

to confirm them with his abundant gifts,

and through his anointing

conform them more fully to Christ, the Son of God.

All pray in silence for a while

Then Celebrant lays hands over all those to be confirmed and says:

Celebrant: Almighty God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,

Who brought these your servants to new birth

by water and the Holy Spirit,

freeing them from sin:

Send upon them, O Lord, the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete; give them the spirit of wisdom and understanding,

the spirit of counsel and fortitude, the spirit of knowledge and piety;

fill them with the spirit of the fear of the Lord.

Through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen.

Pause to allow time for the children to return to their seats.

THE ANOINTING WITH CHRISM

The sacred Chrism is brought to Celebrant.

The children now come up individually with their Sponsor and stand before Celebrant. The sponsor places his/her right hand on the right shoulder of the candidate and hands the confirmation card to the server assisting the celebrant.

Celebrant: (Candidate's confirmation name)

be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Candidate: Amen.

Celebrant : Peace be with you.

Candidate: And with your spirit.

Instrumental or Pre-recorded Music can commence now while the other candidates are being confirmed.

The following is a suggested Universal Prayer. It may be amended to include prayers for the local parish community.

UNIVERSAL PRAYER OF THE CHURCH

Celebrant In confidence and trust, let us place our prayers before our loving and faithful God.

1. We pray for a sense of hope and trust in the promises of God so that we will be

faithful in witnessing to the Gospel and seeking to live fully in the light and love of

Jesus Christ...We pray to the Lord

Response: Lord hear our prayer.

2. We pray for confidence in Christ who is in God's presence forever. May we grow

in awareness that it is He, who pleads for us before God so that the Reign of God is

a reality for all people...We pray to the Lord

Response: Lord hear our prayer.

3. We pray for strength that we may be faithful disciples and examples of the

teaching of Jesus Christ so that all we know will learn something of God's Good

News for the world...We pray for the Lord

Response: Lord hear our prayer.

4. We pray for a sense of joy in this celebration, that as Jesus ascended into heaven,

we are assured that He, who has gone before is preparing a place for us...We pray

to the Lord

Response: Lord hear our prayer.

5. We pray for all those being confirmed and about to receive the Lord in the

Eucharist for the first time, that they will be filled with the very goodness of our

God...We pray to the Lord

Response: Lord hear our prayer.

6. We pray for all in leadership in the Church throughout the world, for Francis our

Pope, for Charles our Celebrant, for our priests who lead us in faith and who share

with us in the joy of the ascended Christ...We pray to the Lord

Response: Lord hear our prayer.

7. We pray....[as per sick on the prayer sheet]

Response: Lord hear our prayer.

Celebrant: Loving God, you have gifted us with the Spirit of Jesus. Listen to all our

prayers and needs that we place before you, through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen

whom he has made his adopted sons and

daughters reborn from water and the Holy Spirit, and may he keep you worthy of his fatherly love.

All: Amen

Celebrant: May his Only Begotten Son,

who promised that the Spirit of truth

would abide in his Church,

bless you, and confirm you by his power

in the confession of the true faith.

All: Amen

Celebrant: May the Holy Spirit,

who kindles the fire of charity in the hearts of disciples, bless you and lead you blameless and gathered as one, into the joy of the Kingdom of God.
