EXTINGUISH: 6 Tealights

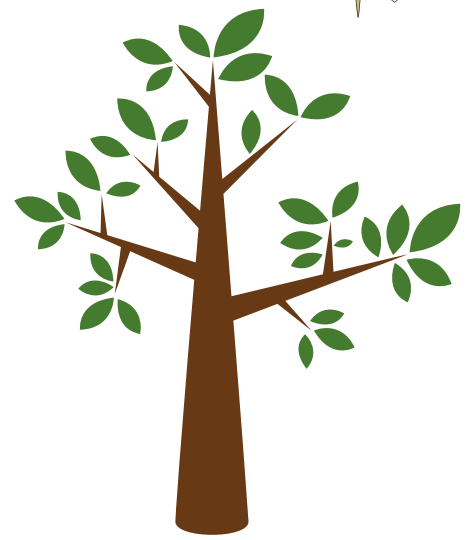
READ: John 12:20-30
